This nuanced coming-of-age story follows 12-year-old Peter Goldsmith as he navigates the developmental upheaval of early adolescence, complicated by being both a Jewish kid in a culturally blended household and a gay kid years away from understanding his own sexuality. With the help of a few supportive adults and his musical fantasy daydreams, Peter takes a few awkward steps along the path to making sense of himself.

Though set in the early 1980's, the themes of *Peter, Peter* -- starting to see one's parents as the flawed, fully human beings they are, and the need to form an identity of one's own -- are universal and timeless. *Peter, Peter* is a film for the 21st century, one that will resonate with young people struggling with similar issues and the adults who've been there before.

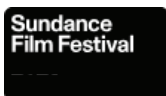
